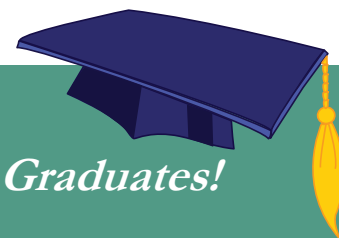

GRANTS AWARDED FROM SPRING CYCLE

This year \$57,527.50 was provided to Orange County’s charitable organizations and purposes through the 2013 grant cycles from the Orange County Child Care Co-Operative, the OCCF Education Fund, and the OCCF Unrestricted Fund. From the three separate grant categories there were a total of 31 applications and \$193,933.25 in grant funding requested; the group selected 20 recipients and awarded a total of \$57,527.50. Applications for these grants were reviewed and selected by diverse committees and received final approval by the OCCF Board of Directors.

Funding provided this year ‘s Child Care Co-Operative Grants include:

Hoosier Uplands Head	\$499.50
Running Start	\$3,000.00
West Baden Springs Police Training	\$1,000.00
Orange County Farm Bureau	\$1,500.00

The grant committee also proactively granted \$1,000 to each of the three county school nurses for a total of \$3,000.00.

The OCCF Education Fund was made possible through the generosity of CAPE, and provides grants to charitable education programs. This year’s grants are as follows:

The grant committee also proactively granted \$2,643.00 to the Orange County Ivy Tech Fund.

YOUTH COUNCIL PROVIDES GRANT FUNDING

The OCCF Youth Council, a training field for blossoming philanthropists, provides grant funding each year to local area non-profits for charitable programs and projects. This year there were five applications and \$16,345.00 in grant funding requested and the group selected three recipients and

awarded a total of \$3,000, including the following:

- Backpacks of Blessings \$1,000.00
- Gateway Ministries \$1,000.00
- Proactively granted \$1,000.00 to Running Start.

Created through the generosity of our donors and the fund-raising efforts of the OCCF Youth Council, this fund annually pays out to local non-profit organizations in grant monies. Selections are made by the youth council members, guided by adult mentors, and are subject to final approval by the OCCF Board of Directors.

FRED AND ETHEL CROWE EDUCATION AWARD

The 2013 Fred and Ethel Crowe Educator Award goes to Holly Vincent! The award honors a teacher who has made an impact in school involvement, community involvement, and one who has had innovative ideas, has shown cooperation and has shown student's achievements. Vincent is the fifth recipient of the award established at the Orange County Community Foundation by Robert and Fredi Crowe in memory of their parents and many year teachers at Paoli schools, Fred and Ethel Crowe. Vincent received a \$500.00 cash award to be used as she wishes.

Mrs. Vincent's outreach extends beyond the classroom as she is actively involved in many programs throughout Orange County. One of Mrs. Vincent's biggest school/community accomplishments is founding of our local *Running Start* program in which she organized a committee of local concerned citizens and teachers and partnered with other non-profits to write grants and seek donations. Through this initiative, at risk Throop students in grades K-3 were invited to come to Throop to be fitted for brand new tennis shoes, and receive a backpack with new school supplies, a book, a t-shirt, a new haircut, a dental screening lunch and much more. Since the program began in February of 2012, \$27,259.00 has been raised toward the project. Her "can do" attitude is contagious and she has inspired many of us around her to "dream big."
